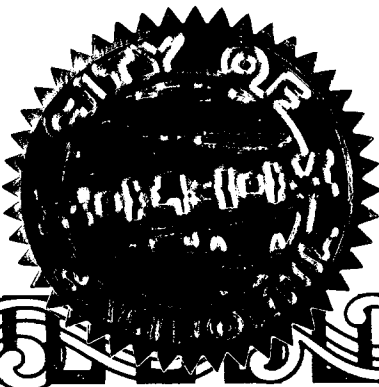
**AL DIENER**
