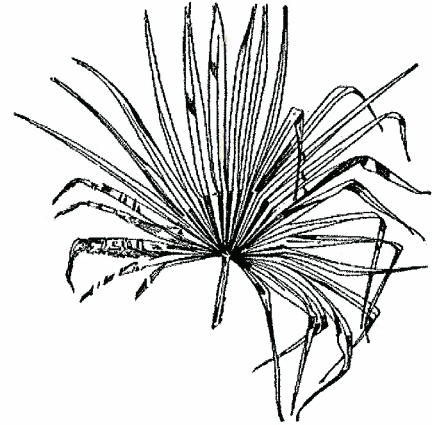



<p> Average Height: 20' Average Canopy: 20' Shape: Clump Leaf: Triangular, fan shaped Flowers: Greenish Fruit/Seed: ½" Diameter orange turning to black Bark: Hairy with leaf stem stubs Other Characteristics: Multi-stem </p>

<div> <div> Average Height: 30' </div> <div> Average Canopy: 8' - 10' </div> <div> Shape: Spray- head </div> <div> Leaf: Evergreen </div> <div> Flowers: Creamy </div> <div> Fruit/Seed: 3/8" Black seeds </div> <div> Bark: Hairy-trunk </div> <div> Other Characteristics: Trunk narrower at bottom and thicker at top </div> </div>			
			
			

California Fan Palm		<i>Washingtonia filifera</i>	
PALM	PALMATE	FAN	
<p>Average Height: 60'</p> <p>Average Canopy: 20'</p> <p>Shape: Spray-head</p> <p>Leaf: Fans with small thorny bracts</p> <p>Flowers: Creamy white</p> <p>Fruit/Seed: ¾"</p> <p>Bark: Gray semi-smooth</p> <p>Other Characteristics: Wider trunk 18" – 30", slow growth, minimal thorns on long leaf stalks, aerial roots at base that are above ground</p>			
   			

PALM		PALMATE	<i>Washingtonia robusta</i>

<div><div><div>Average Height: 100'</div><div>Average Canopy: 10'</div><div>Shape: Spray-head</div><div>Leaf: Smaller fan and short leaf stalk with lots of 1" wide spines</div><div>Flowers: Creamy white</div><div>Fruit/Seed: 1" x 1 1/2" oval, not tasty</div><div>Bark: May have big leaf scars</div><div>Other Characteristics: Narrow trunk 8" – 14" diameter with or w/out old leaf bases remaining</div></div><div></div></div>
