


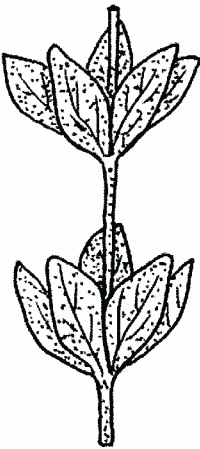

<div>     </div> <p> Average Height: 15' – 30' </p> <p> Average Canopy: 10' – 20' </p> <p> Shape: Clump </p> <p> Leaf: Bare in fall </p> <p> Flowers: Color varies: Pink, Lavender, white </p> <p> Fruit/Seed: Long bean pod </p> <p> Bark: Shaggy and twisted trunks </p> <p> Other Characteristics: Single or multi-stemmed, foliage usually looks sparse, bean pods stay on all winter </p>

BROADLEAF	OPPOSITE	SIMPLE	WHORLED
<div><div><div>Average Height: 40' – 60'</div><div>Average Canopy: 20' – 40'</div><div>Shape: Broad-rounded</div><div>Leaf: Yellow in fall</div><div>Flowers: White-pink</div><div>Fruit/Seed: Long bean pod persistent in fall and winter</div><div>Bark: Grey checkered</div><div>Other Characteristics: Buds and branches usually whorled in 3's</div></div><div></div></div>			



Oracle Oak		<p>Average Height: 30' – 75'</p> <p>Average Canopy: 40' – 80'</p> <p>Shape: Varies</p> <p>Leaf: Semi-leather like</p> <p>Flowers: Catkin in March</p> <p>Fruit/Seed: Acorn</p> <p>Bark: Smooth gray</p> <p>Other Characteristics: Unusual native cross between California Black Oak, Q. kelloggii & Interior Live Oak, Q. wislizenii</p>
