**To be continued to the October 19, 2011 Planning Commission meeting.** A Public Hearing to consider an appeal by Sabrina Reed of a Community Development Department approval of a Design Review Application for construction of a 36-square-foot addition (two-story enclosed spiral staircase) to an existing single-family residence at 124 Darrington Drive. The zoning for the site is R-1-M PD and the General Plan land-use designation is SF. The Planning Commission will take final action on this project unless appealed to the City Council. **(Project Planner: Steve Banks, Senior Planner / Appellant: Sabrina Reed)**

2. **PN11-080, The Island, Planned Development Permit, Rezone, General Plan Amendment, Tentative Subdivision Map, 405 Parkshore Drive**

**To be continued to the October 19, 2011 Planning Commission meeting.** A Public Hearing to consider a request from Lewis Planned Communities for approval of a General Plan Amendment, Specific Plan Amendment, Tentative Subdivision Map and Planned Development Permit for development of a 315-unit residential subdivision on a 34-acres site at 405 Parkshore Drive. The zoning is SP 93-2 with an underlying designation of M-1 PD and the General Plan is IND. An Addendum to the 1992 Silverbrook Island EIR has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act.
