

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 1154

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FOLSOM REPEALING AND RE-ENACTING SECTION 17.52.530 OF THE FOLSOM MUNICIPAL CODE RELEATING TO SIGNS IN THE NATOMA-RILEY-BIDWELL SUBAREA OF THE HISTORIC DISTRICT

Ordinance No. 1154 is scheduled for adoption by the Folsom City Council on October 11, 2011, and if adopted will become effective on November 10, 2011. The purpose of this ordinance is to repeal and re-enact Section 17.52.530 of the Folsom Municipal Code pertaining to signs in the Natoma-Riley-Bidwell Subarea of the Historic District. It is intended to help better accommodate the current signage needs within the Natoma-Riley-Bidwell Subarea by allowing larger freestanding signs for retail uses and restaurants which front on Natoma Street. The proposed ordinance is also intended to help commercial freestanding signs be designed in a way that is compatible with the existing physical characteristics of the Natoma-Riley-Bidwell Subarea.
