Definition Information

From §490 & 490.1 of the Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance

§ 490.1 Applicability

a) After January 1, 2010, this ordinance (AB1881 – Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance) shall apply to all of the following projects:

- 1) new construction and rehabilitation for public agency projects and private development projects with a landscape area equal to or greater than 2,500 square feet requiring a building or landscape permit, plan check or design review;
 - 2) new construction and rehabilitation landscapes which are developer-installed in single family and multi-family projects with a landscape area equal to or greater than 2,500 square feet requiring a building or landscape permit, plan check, or design review
 - 3) new construction landscapes which are homeowner-provided and/or homeowner-hired in a single family and multi-family residential projects with a total project landscape area equal to or greater than 5,000 square feet requiring building or landscape permit, plans check or design review;
 - 4) existing landscapes limited to §493, 493.1, 493.2
 - 5) cemeteries. Recognizes the special landscape management needs of cemeteries, new and rehabilitated cemeteries are limited to §492.4, 492.11, 492.12; and existing cemeteries are limited to § 493, 493.1, & 493.2
- b) This ordinance does not apply to:
- 1) registered local, state or federal historical sites
 - 2) ecological restoration projects that do not require a permanent irrigation system
 - 3) mined-land reclamation projects that do not require a permanent irrigation system; or
 - 4) plant collections, as part of botanical gardens and arboretums open to the public.

Selected definitions from § 491.

(u) "homeowner-provided landscaping" means any landscaping either installed by a private individual for a single family residence or installed by a licensed contractor hired by a homeowner. A homeowner, for the purpose of this ordinance, is a person who occupies the dwelling he or she owns. This excludes speculative homes, which are not owner-occupied dwellings.

(dd) "landscape area" means all the planting areas, turf areas, and water features in a landscape design plan subject to the Maximum Applied Water Allowance calculations. The landscape area does not include footprints of the buildings or structures, sidewalks, driveways, parking lots, decks, patios, gravel or stone walks, other pervious or non-pervious hardscapes, and other non-irrigated areas designated for non-development (e.g., open spaces and existing native vegetation).

(qq) "new construction" means, for the purpose of this ordinance, a new building with a landscape or other new landscape, such as a park, playground, or greenbelt without an associated building.

(eee) "rehabilitated landscape" means any re-landscaping project that requires a permit, plan check, or design review, meets the requirements of § 490.1, and the modified landscape area is equal to or greater than 2,500 sq ft, is 50% of the total landscape area, and the modifications are completed within one year.

(iii) "Special Landscape Area" (SLA) means an area of the landscape dedicated solely to edible plants, areas irrigated with recycled water, water features using recycled water and areas dedicated to active play such as parks, sports fields, golf courses, and where turf provides a playing surface.

(qqq) "water feature" means a design element where open water performs an aesthetic or recreational function. Water features include ponds, lakes, waterfalls, fountains, artificial streams, spas, and swimming pools (where water is artificially supplied). The surface area of water features is included in the high water use hydrozone of the landscape area. Constructed wetlands used for on-site wastewater treatment or storm water best management practices that are not irrigated and used solely for water treatment or storm water retention are not water features and, therefore, are not subject to the water budget calculation.

§ 492.6(2)(C) Surface area of a water feature shall be included in the high water use hydrozone area of the water budget calculation.

§ 492.6(3)(D) Soil amendments shall be incorporated according to recommendations of the soil report and what is appropriate for the plants selected (see Section 492.5).

NOTE: California Green Building Standards Code (Cal Green) takes effect January 1, 2011, with other California State mandated water regulations and may effect design and infrastructure requirements. Please refer to the latest codes.
