3. **PN11-370, AT&T, Conditional Use Permit Modification, 6611 Folsom-Auburn Road**

A Public Hearing to consider a request for approval of a Conditional Use Permit Modification application for installation of 3 new panel antennas at 6611 Folsom-Auburn Road. The proposal also includes expansion of an existing AT&T equipment compound lease area and construction of new equipment cabinets within the lease area. The project is Categorically Exempt from environmental review pursuant to Section 15302 (Replacement or Reconstruction) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). A Public Hearing to consider an appeal by Pamela Reynolds of a Community Development Department Denial of a Design Review Application for construction of a 35-square-foot deck and spiral staircase addition to an existing single-family residence at 323 Randall Drive. The zoning for the site is R-1-M PD and the General Plan land-use designation is SF. The project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Section 15303 (New Construction or Conversion of Small Structures) of the CEQA Guidelines.
