CITIZEN COMMUNICATION: The Historic District Commission welcomes and encourages participation in City Historic District Commission meetings, and will allow up to five minutes for expression on a non-agenda item. Matters under the jurisdiction of the Commission, and not on the posted agenda, may be addressed by the general public; however, California law prohibits the Commission from taking action on any matter which is not on the posted agenda unless it is determined to be an emergency by the Commission.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. PN12-071, Historic Folsom Station Public Plaza and Traders Lane Public Parking Area General Plan Amendment, Rezone, and Zoning Code Text Amendment, Reading Street and 198 Wool Street

A Public Hearing to consider a request from the City of Folsom for approval of a General Plan Amendment and Rezone to change the GP and Zoning designations for the Historic Folsom Station Public Plaza and the Traders Lane Public Parking Area from CA (Specialty Commercial) and HD (Historic District) to PUB (Public) and OSC (Open Space Conservation District). In addition, a Zoning Code Text Amendment is proposed to FMC Section 17.39.020 (OSC, Open Space and Conservation District) relative to permitted uses. The project is categorically exempt from environmental review under Section 15301 of the CEQA Guidelines (Existing Facilities). The Historic District Commission will review this proposal at its March 21, 2012 meeting and make a recommendation to the City Council. **(Project Planner: Steve Banks, Senior Planner / Applicant: City of Folsom)**

The appeal period for Historic District Commission Action: Pursuant to all applicable laws and regulations, including without limitation, California Government Code, Section 65009 and/or California Public Resources Code, Section 21177, if you wish to challenge in court any of the above decisions (regarding planning, zoning, and/or environmental decisions), you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing(s) described in this notice/agenda, or in written correspondence delivered to the City at, or prior to, this public hearing. Any appeal of a Historic District Commission action must be filed, in writing with the City Clerk's Office no later than ten (10) days from the date of the action pursuant to Resolution No. 8081.
