- The Folsom Focus photography contest, started by the FPA in 2005, has grown to include over 270 entries that present the diversity of life in Folsom. Each year the winners and entrants are showcased at the Gallery at 48 Natoma.
- For many years, the FPA presented the annual Gourd and Arts Festival, which brought visitors from throughout the region and served as a great fundraising event for the organization.
- The FPA provides sponsorships to Folsom non-profit arts organizations
- The FPA provides scholarships to local high school graduates seeking further education in the Arts
- They support the school based Reflections art program
- The FPA provides ongoing support to the public Gallery at 48 Natoma.
