

**CITY OF FOLSOM
PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION

REGULAR MEETING MINUTES**

1. **CALL TO ORDER:** The Parks and Recreation Commission meeting was called to order at 6:34p.m. with Chair Walker presiding.

Speaker Jim Kirstein spoke on behalf of the Friends of the Folsom Parkways and stated he will start sending the Friends newsletter to the commission.

Speaker Vincent Adeszko stated his concerns regarding off-road vehicles on the trails above the Hinkle Creek Nature Center and suggested that the City post signage prohibiting off-road vehicles.

A. Memorandum of Understanding with Folsom Lacrosse Association

This item was continued to the next Parks and Recreation Commission meeting.

7. **DISCUSSION ITEM:**
A. Folsom Municipal Code Modifications Related to Folsom Bike Trail Use

Park Planning Manager Jim Simpson presented the staff report. He explained that staff and the subcommittee have been reviewing the different modes of power-driven devices and met with the stakeholder user groups and held a community workshop to seek input from the public. He provided a summary of the efforts and input to date.

There was discussion between staff and the commission on what other communities allow on their trails, enforcement, signage and educating the public.

Speaker Vincent Adeszko stated he attended the community workshop and believes signage is important as people interpret the use or types of trails differently.

Speaker Jim Kirstein stated that he is a proponent of only muscle powered vehicles and is not in favor of electric bikes, segways, etc.

Director Goss stated that the item would be brought back at the May or June meeting after staff has had time to do more research to determine what other cities are doing.

B. Fiscal Year 2012-13 Capital Improvement Projects Budget

Director Goss reviewed the Capital Improvement Projects that are currently being worked on that will take staff into the next fiscal year. He explained that the ongoing economic recession has continued to impact the Park Impact Fee Fund to the point that no new Park Development projects are being proposed for Fiscal Year 2012-13.

C. FIDO Field Renovation Update

Park Planning Manager Simpson presented an update on the renovation of FIDO Field at Cummings Family Park. He stated that the project should be complete in July or August.

D. Recreation Program cost Analysis

Director Goss reviewed the program cost analysis that staff went through as part of the budget process for the upcoming Fiscal Year 2012-13 Parks and Recreation Budget. He explained that the draft budget will be presented to the City Council next Tuesday, April 10th.

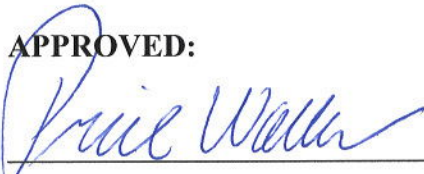
There being no further business before the Parks and Recreation Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 8:21 p.m.
