Subject: **LSTA GRANT FUNDS AWARDED FOR ONLINE HOMEWORK HELP**

BACKGROUND/ISSUE

At its June 24, 2008, meeting, the City Council approved Resolution No. 8318 - A Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Apply for and Accept LSTA Grant Funds Awarded by the State Library for one year of access to Out-of-School-Time Online Homework Help.

The Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) is the successor to the Library Services and Construction Act (LSCA) and its predecessors, in effect since 1956. Enacted October 1, 1996 and reauthorized in 2003, the LSTA is administered in California by the California State Library. Each year since the inception of the Act, the California State Librarian has awarded local assistance grants on a competitive basis for locally initiated proposals that meet the purposes of the Act. The LSTA provides support for projects in the areas of services for special populations, technology, resource sharing and inter-agency cooperation. Grants are awarded on a competitive basis.

For the past six years, the California State Library has used LSTA funds to subscribe to Out-of-School-Time Online Homework Help. More than forty library jurisdictions are currently providing access to Out-of-School-Time Online Homework Help with financial support from LSTA funds. The Folsom Public Library applied for the Out-of-School-Time Online Homework Help grant in May 2008, and received notification of the grant award in June 2008. The original grant award provides full funding for FY 2008/09 and the option to renew in subsequent years with an incremental decrease in funding support from the State Library through FY 2010/11.

Students will access Out-of-School-Time Online Homework Help through a link on each participating library's Web site. The goal of the program is to provide after-school homework assistance to students, grades 3-12.

ANALYSIS

After the school day ends, students sometimes find themselves without the support of an older student or adult who can help them to understand how to complete a homework assignment. The Folsom Public Library offers after-school homework help provided three days a week by volunteers in its Folsom Library After-School Hours (F.L.A.S.H.). Students who aren't able to come to the library may not have the same opportunities for assistance after school.

The Out-of-School-Time Online Homework Help program supplements educational services to all students in the community by way of the Folsom Public Library's online connection to expert tutors in English and Spanish for nine hours a day, seven days a week . By combining free computer access at the Library with the free tutoring assistance of Out-of-School-Time Online Homework Help, this project helps to create equal opportunities for learning and growth for all students. To use this service, users will start from the Folsom Public Library home page.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The project is fully funded for the FY08-09 and requires no matching local funds. The cost for one full year of access to the Out-of-School-Time Online Homework Help program is \$10,500. The original grant award provides full funding for FY 2008/09 with the option to renew or not in subsequent years with an incremental decrease in funding support from the State Library through FY 2010/11. The Folsom Public Library would be required to provide 25% of the subscription cost in year two, 50% in year three and 100% in year four and beyond. The chart below illustrates the levels of support that the California State Library and the Folsom Public library anticipate they will share through this grant.

To determine if LSTA support will continue to be offered in FY 2008/09 and beyond, the Library will review the service annually. The City will have the option not to renew this service during any of the subsequent years. The Library will review its budget for materials and online resources, analyze patron usage of the service, and examine library service priorities to decide whether to recommend reallocation of resources within the Library's existing budget in order to pay for the service at the higher rates. Based on the results of the service and upon review and prioritization of the Library's budget for materials and online resources, the Library would decide whether to recommend expenditures within its existing budget to pay for the higher rates to access Out-of-School-Time Online Homework Help.

2008-2009 LIBRARY BUDGET

At its June 24, 2008, meeting, the City Council approved Resolution No. 8312 - A Resolution Adopting the FY 2008-09 Final Budget for the City of Folsom, the Folsom Redevelopment Agency, and the Folsom Public Financing Authority. There had been no public comment on the library portion of the budget during the public hearing process. No changes were made to the library's budget as presented to the Library Commission on June 2, 2008.

Changes to the library open hours at Folsom Public Library, Georgia Murray Building were approved as part of the 2008-09 budget. The library will be closed on Monday evenings at 5 p.m. beginning on Monday July 21, 2008.
