#### I. CALL TO ORDER L&L DISTRICTS ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order by Vice Chair Joe Marceau. Members present: Joe Marceau (Natoma Station); David Weizer (ARCN#2), Frank Kennedy (Steeplechase); Patty Soulsby (Blue Ravine Oaks); Allen Brown (ARCN); Mary Mast (Cobble Hills/Reflections). Six members present; a quorum of six is required.

- **II. APPROVAL OF MINUTES-**A motion was made by Frank Kennedy and seconded by Mary Mast to approve the November 15, 2012 Minutes. The motion was approved unanimously.

**ARCN-**Member Allen Brown asked if the mistletoe in the pear trees along Oak Avenue could be removed.

**Blue Ravine Oaks-**Member Patty Soulsby commented that an irrigation pipe fix needed to occur from the project; she also commented that she observed the root barriers being installed for the tree wells; and wanted to know if the City will be instructing the residents on how to water and take care of the newly planted trees and shrubs.

**Steeplechase-**Member Frank Kennedy asked staff if they would look at a fence along Riley Street and repair it if it was a city fence.

**ARCN#2-**Member Dave Weizer discussed the need for a project to clear out the overgrown berries along the path in Unit 6B where the creek over tops the path with debris.
