



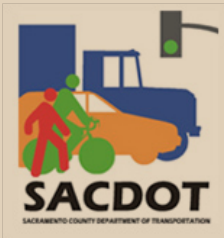

# Great Scott! (Road) Bike & Walk Event

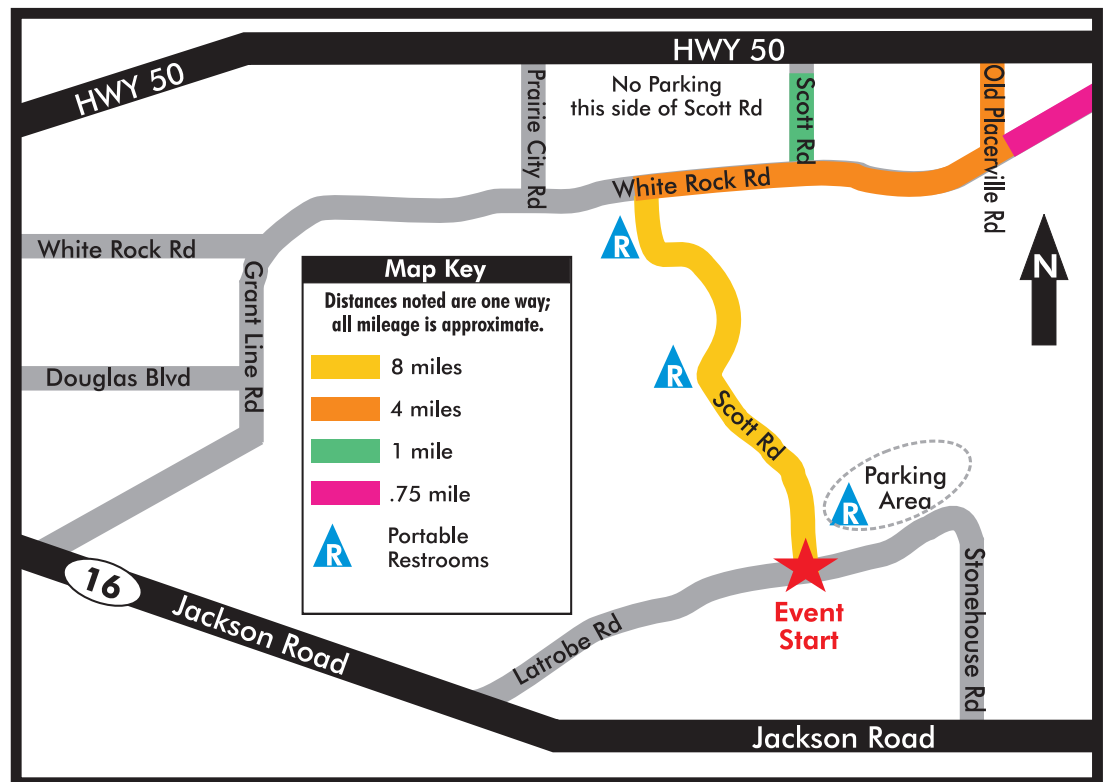
**Sunday, May 5, 2013 · 8 a.m.-4 p.m.**

**Scenic roads closed to traffic for this special one-day event!**

In support of regional "May is Bike Month," the Sacramento County Department of Transportation (SACDOT) and the City of Folsom are closing a section of Scott Road (from White Rock Road to Latrobe Road) and segments of White Rock and Old Placerville roads, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Sunday, May 5.

Scott Road is the eastern portion of Sacramento County and is one of the most scenic roadways in the area. These road closures will provide bicyclists and pedestrians with an opportunity to ride and walk on roadways with no vehicle traffic. Along the route, participants will enjoy views of the Sierra Nevada mountains, lush vegetation, and terrain that includes rolling hills.

**Access and parking:** Parking is available at the Palladio in Folsom (E. Bidwell between Iron Point Road and Broadstone Pkwy.) and at the Latrobe Road (south) end of Scott Road (see map below). Bicyclists and pedestrians may enter the ride route at either end of Scott Road.



**NOTE:** Scott Road will be closed to vehicles; detours will be available. Access for Scott Road residents will be maintained.

No water is available on the route; please bring your own. Portable restroom facilities will be available at three locations along Scott Road.
