Parks and programs remaining (*new potential programming in italics*).
Number refers to keyed map location

1. **Bud & Artie Davies Park:** Ballfield, walkway, parking lot, and Santa Juanita Avenue frontage improvements.
2. **Lew Howard Park:** Lighted tennis courts, turf volleyball court.
3. **Hinkle Creek Center & Nature Area:** Trail, bridges, interpretive overlooks, outdoor classroom (amphitheater style), pervious pavement parking lot, covered entry area.
4. **Lembi Community Park:** O.S. trail, trail boardwalk, Aquatic Center classrooms, additional aquatic feature, picnic area, Group picnic areas (*possible reservable*).
5. **Livermore Community Park:** - Phase 5: Parking (new & renovated), tennis/basketball courts, bike trail, walkways, landscape (*community garden*) restroom, play area, and lighting.
6. **Willow Hill Community Park:** Group picnic area, elevated fishing deck, floating dock, turf plantings, tree plantings. *Possible reservable second group picnic area.*
7. **John Kemp Community Park:** Field 1 bleachers & walkway.
8. **Beacon Hill Park:** Play area.
9. **BT Collins Park:** Restroom, irrigated turf, basketball court, group picnic area
10. **Briggs Mini Park:** (Undeveloped park site cut out on August tour due to timing)
11. **Ed Mitchell Park:** Lighted FCUSD tennis courts. *Possible reservable group picnic area.*

Note: Rodeo Park is not listed as the only remaining items are the restroom (which is in the FY 13-14 CIP) and site furnishings.
