A. Tour of Public Art of the sculptures in the Folsom Public Art Collection

The commissioners proceeded via city vehicles to a tour of city-owned public art led by Ms Abraham and Ms Linnane. An overview of the public art program was given with basic vocabulary and policy issues detailed. Sites were then visited including the "Rockin' River" sculpture at 48 Natoma, and "Oak Leaves" at the light-rail Glenn Station. The commissioners went on to view over 15 sculpture installations at median strips and park settings in the Natoma Station neighborhood. Various types of art and sculpture materials were examined with long-term successes and failures discussed. Vandalism, theft and environmental wear were pointed out.
