

Residents and business owners may take advantage of water efficiency services and information including free Water Wise House Calls, large landscape irrigation audits, commercial water audits, public education and rebate programs. ### Free Water Wise House Calls

Did you know that up to 70 percent of residential water use typically occurs outdoors? Call today for a free Water Wise House Call. City water conservation experts will inspect your landscape and irrigation system and assist in programming controllers. You will also receive brochures on water-wise landscaping and tips on interior conservation.

Water Wise House Calls are typically scheduled on weekdays during business hours and take approximately one hour. Residents must be home to allow access to gated yards and to learn how to set automatic controllers for maximum efficiency.

### Water Conservation Tips

Water is one of our most precious resources, and conservation is critical during this time of drought. Please follow these tips to conserve:

- Be aware of drought related landscape watering restrictions. Visit [www.folsom.ca.us](http://www.folsom.ca.us) for up-to-date information.
- Water during cooler times of day for maximum absorption.
- Adjust sprinklers to avoid watering sidewalks, driveways and gutters.
- Use a broom rather than a hose when cleaning sidewalks and driveways.
- Use automatic shut-off nozzles when hand watering or washing vehicles.
- Cover swimming pools to reduce water loss due to evaporation.
- Avoid letting faucets run while washing hands or shaving.
- Fix leaky faucets.
- Only run the dishwasher and washing machine when you have a full load.
- Consider purchase of water efficient dishwashers and washing machines.
- Install low-flow showerheads.
- Reduce shower times to no more than five minutes.
