To prevent misuse and keep medications from entering our waterways, please dispose of unused prescription and over-the-counter medications responsibly.

Proper disposal is as easy as 1-2-3

1. Prior to drop-off, remove pills from containers and put in a clear zipper bag. Keep medicated liquids and creams in original containers.
2. Recycle your empty containers, but first scratch off or black out personal information.
3. Find a medication collection bin near you (see disposal options on reverse) and place zipper bags, liquids, and creams in the bin.

Only household prescription, over-the-counter, and pet medications are accepted. Controlled medications accepted at select locations. No sharps or business
