SUBJECT: **RESOLUTION NO. 8596 – A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TRANSFER OWNERSHIP OF TWO (2) FOLSOM POLICE MOTORCYCLES TO THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATION CENTER (EVOC) IN EXCHANGE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING**

BACKGROUND / ISSUE

The Folsom Police Department is mandated by the California Peace Officers Standards and Training (POST) to maintain Peace Officers' perishable skills every two (2) years relating to emergency vehicle operations. The Police Department utilizes the Sacramento County Emergency Vehicle Operations Center (EVOC), operated by the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department, to provide this training. In FY 2008-2009 the Police Department was billed by the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department approximately \$10,000.00 to complete this training.

POLICY / RULE

The donation of City property requires City Council approval.

ANALYSIS

The Folsom Police Department currently has two (2) Harley Davidson motorcycles which are scheduled to be sold. These motorcycles are out of warranty, have high mileage, and are in need of costly service on a regular basis. With the current purchase of seven (7) new 2009 BMW motorcycles, these Harley Davidson motorcycles will not be utilized for police services. The Sacramento County Sheriff's Department has a need for motorcycles which will be used by students for training. In exchange for these motorcycles the Sacramento County Sheriff's Department has agreed to provide the Folsom Police Department ongoing EVOC training equaling the fair market value (\$21,000) of the motorcycles. The Sacramento County Sheriff's Department and the Folsom Police Department will enter into a Memorandum of Understanding which is in a form approved by the City Attorney's Office.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no fiscal impact associated with this agreement. A fair market value was obtained from Folsom Harley Davidson for both of the motorcycles.



RESOLUTION NO. 8596

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO TRANSFER OWNERSHIP OF TWO (2) FOLSOM POLICE MOTORCYCLES TO THE SACRAMENTO COUNTY EMERGENCY VEHICLE OPERATION CENTER (EVOC) IN EXCHANGE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT TRAINING

WHEREAS, the Folsom Police Department has two (2) high mileage, out of warranty motorcycles; and,

WHEREAS, the Sacramento County Emergency Vehicle Operation Center (EVOC) has agreed to accept the transfer and title of these training motorcycles in exchange for future mandated training; and,

WHEREAS, the Sacramento County Emergency Vehicle Operation Center (EVOC) will agree to exchange, for training, the fair market value assessed for the motorcycles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Folsom hereby authorizes the transfer of ownership of the listed motorcycles to the Sacramento County Emergency Vehicle Operation Center, in exchange for future mandated training at their facility. The City Manager or his designee, is hereby authorized to and empowered to execute in the name of the City of Folsom all necessary contracts, agreements, and amendment requests hereto for the purposes of securing the agreement between the Sacramento County Emergency Vehicle Operations Center and Folsom Police.
