**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION NO. 8717 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS INTEGRATION FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A SECURITY SYSTEM FOR THE POLICE FACILITY**

**BACKGROUND / ISSUE**

On May 12, 2009, the City Council conducted a public hearing on the use of Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Supplemental Law Enforcement Services Fund (SLESF), Citizens Option for Public Safety (COPS) grant funds. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Council adopted Resolution No. 8483, authorizing the use of these funds to, in part, purchase replacement security equipment for the police facility.

**POLICY/RULE**

Section 2.36.080 of the Folsom Municipal Code requires that contracts in excess of \$41,750 be awarded by the City Council. Additionally, Section 2.36.140 of the Folsom Municipal Code allows sole source procurements without competition.

**ANALYSIS**

The Police facility was constructed in 1991. Construction included equipping the secure facility with a video monitoring system which would allow dispatchers to monitor perimeter access points. Of the nineteen cameras and monitors installed during construction, all but two cameras and one monitor are broken and no longer serviceable.

The Police Department received grant funding to replace the inoperable monitoring equipment. Technological developments in the area of video and audio monitoring have advanced quite a bit since the original equipment was installed during building construction. New technology incorporates video monitoring with analytical sorting and digital recording.

The 3VR Intelligent Surveillance and Search Platform makes it possible to organize these vast stores of raw data into rich information that can be quickly and comprehensively searched and mined to fight crime, protect people, and improve customer service and business efficiency.

The 3VR Platform is the first intelligent video management system built on a powerful video search engine allowing customers to conduct investigations up to 75% faster. With advanced video analytics and the ability to correlate video with information from other mission critical business systems, 3VR helps keep people more safe and reduces the effect of fraud and loss on businesses by as much as 80%.

The platform applies 3VR's innovative technology breakthroughs to make capturing, analyzing, correlating, managing and searching video footage easier and faster than any other method. In addition, the platform is easy to manage and maintain — troubleshooting and upgrades can be done remotely, avoiding costly onsite service charges.

3VR is the security standard for hundreds of global customers, including leading banks, retailers, cities, and government and law enforcement agencies. Surveillance Systems Integration (SSI) is the sole source provider of 3VR technology in the Sacramento region able to provide equipment and maintenance.

SSI has provided a contract price of \$62,333.67 for equipping and installing a 3VR surveillance system with associated components at the police facility.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

Funds for this purchase, in the amount of \$62,333.67, are contained in the FY 2010-2011 General Fund.



**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS INTEGRATION FOR THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF A 3VR SECURITY SYSTEM FOR THE POLICE FACILITY**

**WHEREAS**, the Police facility is a secure building housing the City's 911 system and emergency communications center; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police facility security system has exceeded its serviceable life; and

**WHEREAS**, 3VR technology captures, analyzes, correlates, manages and searches video footage; and

**WHEREAS**, Surveillance Systems Integration is the sole source provider for 3VR technology in the Sacramento region; and

**WHEREAS**, sufficient funds for this purchase have been received from the State COPS Grant and are contained in the General Fund.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Folsom City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement, in a form acceptable to the City Attorney, with Surveillance Systems Integration to purchase security equipment for the Police facility an amount not to exceed \$62,333.67.
