**SUBJECT: APPOINTMENT OF CITY OF FOLSOM REPRESENTATIVE TO THE

BACKGROUND / ISSUE

The City of Folsom participates as a member of the City/County Solid Waste Advisory Committee. The Solid Waste Advisory Committee advises the Sacramento Regional County Solid Waste Authority regarding the County of Sacramento Integrated Waste Management plan and all of its planning elements including public education, source reduction, recycling, composting, transformation, materials recovery/resource recovery and marketing, and refuse and recyclables storage, collection, transfer, processing, and disposal.

POLICY / RULE

The City of Folsom's representative on the City/County Solid Waste Advisory Committee shall be a resident appointed by the City Council. (County of Sacramento Resolution No. 2000-1046)

ANALYSIS

The City of Folsom's current representative is Patrick Maxfield. Mr. Maxfield has served as the city's representative from January 2002 through December 2005, and is eligible for re-appointment to another two-year term. Mr. Maxfield has confirmed that he is willing to serve another two-year term. The City has also received additional applications from Robert Bailey, Steven Bruce and Robert McChesney.





I have been a resident of the City of Folsom since March 1983. I have seen the transformation in our Recycling efforts in the past 23 years, and I am excited about the opportunity of serving as your Local Representative to the City/County on the Solid Waste Advisory Committee. I currently have over 20 years of Industry experience. My career in the Waste Industry began upon my graduation from California State University Sacramento with a degree in Marketing and Communication Studies in June of 1981.

I was hired by Browning Ferris Industries as a Sales Team Member in December 1981. After several years I was promoted to the District Sales Manager. My responsibilities included managing a Sales Team, whose primary interest was to acquire and manage Industrial and Commercial accounts in the Sacramento Area.

In 1989 I was recruited by USA Waste in Sacramento (DBA Sac Val Disposal) to manage their Sales force. After several years in that position I accepted the District Manager's position of Sac Val Disposal. I worked closely with both the County and City of Sacramento, setting up the first Multi Housing Recycling Program in the Sacramento Market Area. Our program included a 7.5 gallon plastic buckets which were issued to each apartment resident. This allowed the tenants to commingle their recycled items, which were then deposited in the Commingled Recycling Container.

In January 2000, Waste Management asked that I assume the General Manager Position at El Dorado Disposal located in Diamond Springs, California. I was responsible for managing the 4 Franchise Agreements that Waste Management had with El Dorado Hills CSD, Cameron Park CSD, City of Placerville and El Dorado County. I work very closely with City Managers, Council Member's, Board of Supervisors, County Governments and Directors of Community Service Districts. Our service area included the Western Slope of El Dorado County. I also was responsible for the processing of all the Waste & Recycling Material that we collected and transported to the Western El Dorado Recovery Site (WERS) located in Diamond Springs. This site was permitted to accept up to 400 tons per day of material. (Self-Haul & Commercial Waste) I also operated several State Certified Beverage Container Redemption Site, and a Household Hazardous Waste Center. I was responsible for putting in the first 3-Cart System in El Dorado Hill Community Service District. This program continues to gain acceptance and is currently being added to other part of El Dorado County.

In conclusion, I am confident that my strong leadership and 20+ years of Industry Experience is the winning combination that you are looking for a Folsom representative to the City/County Solid Waste Advisory Committee. I look forward to further discussing this opportunity

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



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

This application is to serve as Folsom's representative to the City/County Solid Waste Advisory Committee.

I am a Canadian citizen and area resident since 1972, engaged full time in the technical and business aspects of solid waste recovery and have been instrumental in the design and implementation of more than fifty waste recycling systems.

Many wastes have potential value as energy but this value is difficult to realize because wastes typically contain about half the energy of fossil fuels, do not occur in large deposits, and commercially available processes frequently do not meet new regulatory requirements.

The 1972 Clean Water Act, the 1993 EPA CFR Title 40, Part 503, and subsequent regulations place strict limits on what can be done with wastes.

New technologies are available but few, in themselves, are a creditable complete solution to a specific waste problem.

As the principal of Down Stream Recovery Service, I am a project developer/service provider focussed on assembling the most effective process components into complete systems to solve both the environmental and economic issues relating to each waste recycling problem.
