SUBJECT: **DESIGNATION OF VOTING DELEGATE FOR THE LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES 2006 ANNUAL CONFERENCE BUSINESS MEETING**

BACKGROUND / ISSUE

The League of California Cities 2006 Annual Conference is scheduled for September 6 through September 9 in San Diego. One aspect of the annual conference is the annual business meeting where the membership takes action on conference resolutions. The League is requesting that the City Council designate a voting representative who will be registered at the conference and who will be present at the annual business meeting.

Interim Deputy City Manager Evert Palmer has indicated that he plans to attend the Annual Conference, and that he is willing to serve as the City's designated representative.


POLICY / RULE

The League of California Cities bylaws state that any official of a city may, with the approval of the City Council, be named as the City's designated voting delegate to any League meeting.

RECOMMENDATION / CITY COUNCIL ACTION

Staff recommends that the City Council designate Interim Deputy City Manager Evert Palmer as the voting delegate for the League of California Cities 2006 Annual Conference business meeting.
