Member Mattocks (Prospect Ridge): Reported that trash has been accumulating in the shrub beds along Levy Road.

Member Cornell (Willow Creek Estates South): Reported out that the Wellfleet Minipark sign is looking like it might need to be replaced in the near future, and is showing signs of rot. Would like to make the new sign match the existing new monument signs. Also, requested copies of the current expenses for his district.

Member Heiler (Los Cerros): Informed of the recent damage a vehicle ran into the “Los Cerros” monument sign off East Bidwell. Wanted to make sure this was on the radar to be replaced. Also, reiterated that the funds are recovered for the damages, so the District is stuck with the cost of replacement.

Member Marceau (Natoma Station): Reported that he has noticed roots from tree’s adjacent to sidewalks in Bigfoot park are damaging the sidewalks.

Member Stanfield (Sierra Estates): Looking for some clean-up at the entrance to Sierra Estates. Stated a large Crepe Myrtle near the entrance is blocking the light and causing it to be really dark at night.

Member Enos (Broadstone #3): Requested to look at adding mulch to freshen up the landscaped areas in Broadstone #3 in the future.
