FOLSOM WINTER SHELTER IN BRIEF

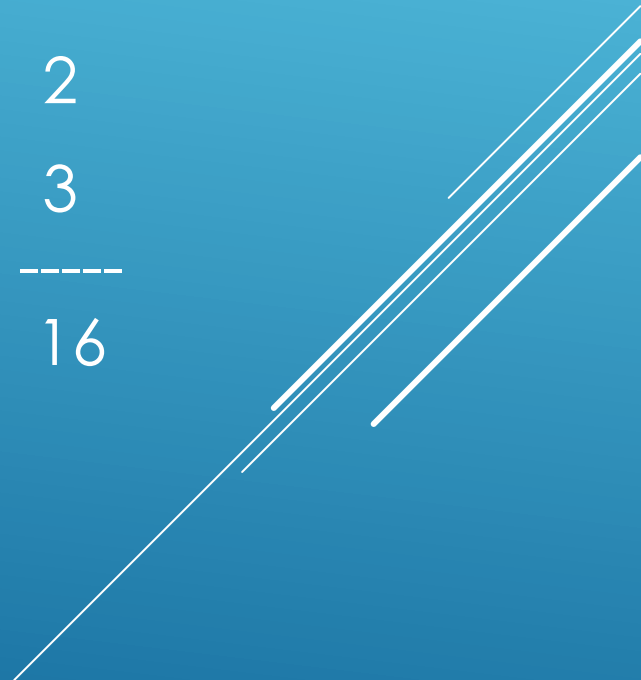
- ▶ Number of nights shelter open **59**
- ▶ Number of guests served **47**
- ▶ Number of guest nights **693**
- ▶ Average guests per night **12**
- ▶ **64%** Men, **36%** Women
- ▶ Oldest Guest: **72**; Youngest Guest: **22**
- ▶ Veterans: **11%**
- ▶ Guests in Folsom prior to season: **73%**

FOLSOM WINTER SHELTER GUESTS

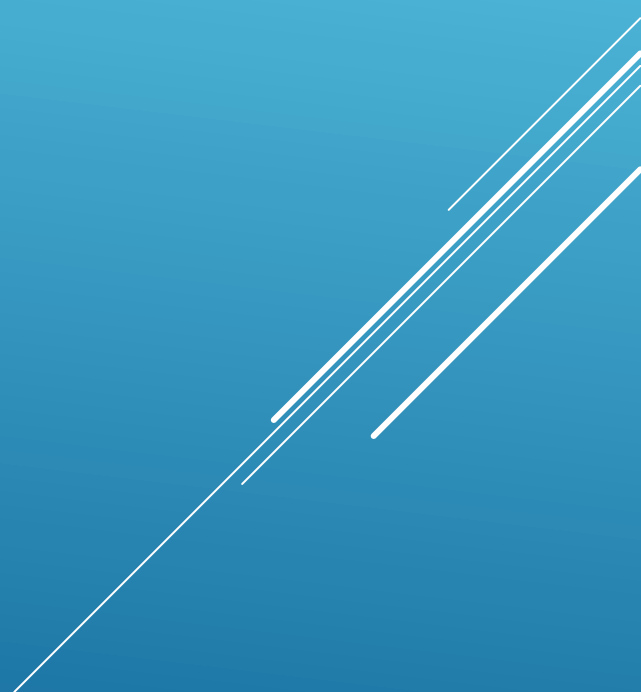
- ▶ Guests working during shelter 3
